Crisis & Mental Health Resources

The National Alliance on Mental Illness Minnesota (NAMI-MN) and community partners throughout the state are partnering to support Minnesotans experiencing behavioral health challenges by broadening outreach about crisis resources. The Crisis Mental Health Resources document is an easy-to-read handout which has been translated into Spanish, Somali, Hmong, and Ojibwe. There are plans to promote the resource in a variety of public settings including libraries, clinics, public health departments, schools, senior centers, and food pantries. Please utilize the resource in your community with people who could benefit from the information.

The Medica Foundation is a nonprofit, charitable grant-making foundation for community-based programs and services. The Medica Foundation believes that everyone deserves a fair and just opportunity to be as healthy as possible. Relationships drive our work as we engage our partners in developing ways to address challenges that face the communities we serve.

Rural Health is one of the key funding areas for the Foundation, and rural health applications are being accepted from July 1 – September 6, 2024. We aim to fund nonprofit, community-led solutions that address health needs and social determinants of health in rural communities. Examples include funding for caregiver/respite services, technology, transportation, program supplies, dental care and food security. Funding is available to organizations located outside of the seven-county Twin Cities metropolitan area in Minnesota.

Benefit Spotlight: Dental Care Coordination

Seeing the dentist has become more challenging across the state. That's why we've partnered for many years with Delta Dental of Minnesota (DDMN) to provide Dental Care Coordination (DCC) for members on all Medica Medicaid plans.

DCC helps overcome dental access barriers. Our **county partners** and **care coordinators** have direct access to DCC and can conference in with members in real-time. DCC helps:

- Find a dentist
- Schedule an appointment
- Get a ride and/or interpreter when needed
- Give appointment reminders
- Schedule follow-up appointments

Dental Care Coordination can be reached by calling **651-994-5198** (Toll Free 866-303-8138, TTY 711). DCC is available from 8am-5pm, Monday-Friday. Members can also access DCC through member service at DDMN if they've been unsuccessful finding a dentist.
